Join us Wednesday morning to hear Keynote Speaker Brian O'Connor. Brian, now in his 11th season as Head Coach of the University of Virginia's baseball program, is a three-time winner of ACC's Coach of the Year award and two-time National Coach of the Year recipient.

Under his direction, the UVA team advanced to their first College World Series in 2009 which lead to a record 245 wins in a five-year period, the most victories of any Division I program during that time. Fifty-one of O'Connor's Virginia players have been selected in the Major League Baseball First-Year Draft, including a school-record nine players in 2010 and eight in 2011.

Join us to hear Coach O'Connor talk about leadership strategies and team building and share some anecdotes from his stellar career in college baseball.
