Attributes: This is one of the most significant and spectacular concrete structures ever built in the New River Valley. The \$100 million Moss Performing Arts Center was named in tribute to Patricia Buckley Moss, whose \$10 million donation to the center was one of the largest gifts ever given to the University. It includes visual arts galleries, amphitheater, four-story experimental cube, multiple studios and a 1,260-seat performance hall. It also offers a multimedia studio, production control room, newsroom and associated classrooms in support of Virginia Tech's Department of Communication.
