Agenda Item IV: VRMCA Items

- Discussion regarding getting info to association members in a timely manner:

 - How long is a producer liable for concrete that has yet to be tested at jobsite GKuhn
 - How to quickly locate info in various codes/standards and putting technical terminology into laymen's terms; short blurbs; links to reference documents – BNeal

Agenda Item VI: Technical Bulletins

- BNeal noted all 6 Technical Bulletins updated to 2015 USBC
- Potential topic for TB #7: Concrete Specifications Why Water Cement Ratio: Why Not
 - Draft from BNeal presented.
 - Noted that language is very similar to SIP2 Limits on Water-cementitious materials ratio.
 - ACTION ITEM: Request committee members review both and provide feedback to moving TB#7 forward or would consider SIP2 sufficient?
- GKuhn requested members to propose new topics with background to facilitate committee discussion

Agenda Item VII: VDOT Coop Update

- VDOT changing concept of Coop to smaller, designated, membership
 - Last Tech Comm mtg followed by brainstorm session with Larry Lundy and Bill Bailey of VDOT.
 - o Group decided on 5 representatives from each, VRMCA & VDOT.
 - VRMCA representatives to be 5
 - Technical Committee Chairman will automatically be 1 of the 5 members.
 - A minimum of 3 of the 5 shall be producer members.
 - ACTION ITEM: Chairman requesting nominations from committee prior to next meeting for vote and recommendation to the Board.

Agenda Item VIII: VDOT Items

- Items reviewed with LLundy and BBailey:
 - TL27 Creating an Option 4 for one-off mixes that may not have supporting data or mix curves. Recommended adding Option 4 to proposed Options 2/3 form instead of creating another new form. VDOT receptive to idea.
 - TL28 VDOT receptive to 2 options presented:
 - Use existing form TL28A
 - Use proposed TL28B form, but must include batch weights on all delivery tickets
 - Low Cracking SRA to be included on Approved List with fixed dosage rates
 - ACTION ITEM: VDOT requests formal proposal from VRMCA TC
 - -#200 Fines This item has been split into two separate items
 - Use of non-spec graded fine aggregate within Options 2 & 3 (& 4)
 - Use of higher -#200 fines content within fine aggregate (up to 10%)
 - ACTION ITEM: VDOT requesting language proposal from VRMCA TC for separating the 2 and adopting the non-spec graded allowance.
 - Retarder Set Time no movement
 - Admixture Dispensing VDOT acceptance if within accordance with NRMCA?
 - ACTION ITEM: VDOT requesting language proposal from VRMCA TC
 - ACI 318 Mix Acceptance to adopt ACI method of mix validation (1200 psi)
 - ACTION ITEM: VDOT requesting language proposal from VRMCA TC

- Electronic Delivery Tickets
 - Some producers have capability or are moving forward with such.
 - VDOT indicates their infrastructure is not capable to handle this level of technology though recognizes the desire and need to keep up with technological advancements.

Agenda Item IX: New Items of Business

ACTION ITEM: Chairman asked how can TC author communications that becomes an "industry" document, not just seen as coming from a disgruntled producer. Could be a TB or some other communication piece.

- Guest Speaker: William Gaspar gave his structural engineer perspective, to include:
 - o Testing Technician training vs Engineers knowledge
 - Testing techniques and tools
 - Pre-placement meetings key
- <u>ACTION ITEM:</u> Chairman proposed TC develop a working group to revamp ACI Training Classes
 to address issues like improper testing techniques, etc., and their adverse effect on concrete
 producers. Not just teach how to conduct tests per standards but to increase emphasis on
 knowledge-based testing.
