The curriculum committee will review all late arrivals and early departures to determine if they should be considered a full absence. Active participation in group planning meetings is also expected of all participants. You are expected to complete all assignments on a timely basis and participate at a high level, as measured by your attendance and activity level.

#### **COMMITMENT POLICY** -

Each participant is expected to volunteer for a VRMCA committee and/or participate in their local VRMCA chapter meetings and events.

#### PAYMENT & ACCEPTANCE POLICY —

The application fee for the VRMCA's Concrete Leadership Program is \$3,000. If accepted into the program, your company will be invoiced and the fee will be due by August 31, 2022. If no payment has been received by the payment deadline, an alternate participant will be chosen as a replacement. Participants who wish to withdraw after submitting payment must do so in writing.
